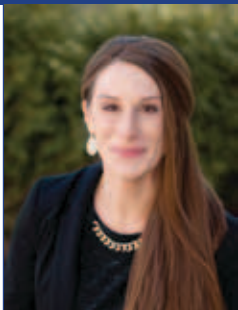


Faith and family are very important to me and my motivation for everything. It's important for me to understand what motivates my patients as we make decisions to support their health and their own priorities.
